

HOW TO EDIT YOUR PERSONAL OR TEAM PAGE

Things to Consider?

- Personal and Team Fundraising Pages have default content when you register for an event.
 <u>However, we highly recommend that you personalize your page(s) to tell your own (or your team's) story and why the event is important to you.</u>
- **Only Team Captains** will have access to edit the Team Fundraising Page from their Participant Center.

1. Change the title/heading of your page.

Note: You can only change the headline of your personal page; on your team page, your team name will appear here.

- Upload a new picture or add a YouTube video to your page. NOTE: You can pick either a photo or a video, <u>but not both</u>.
- 3. Click 'Edit Story" to change your message/personal story that appears on the page.



Editing Your Personal Story



- After clicking "Edit Story," a format menu will appear. Here you can change the font size, add text elements like **bold**, *italic*, or <u>underline</u>. You can also select the alignment of your text as well as insert hyperlinks to other web pages or content.
- 2. This area is where you will type and/or edit your personal story.
- 3. When you are done editing your page, be sure to click the "Save" button.



Changing Your Personal Page URL

- 1. Return to your Participant Center homepage.
- 2. Scroll to the bottom of the page to the "Me" or "My Team" tab.
- 3. In the "Personal Page" or "Team Page" box, click the "URL Settings."

- 4. A pop-up will appear with instructions on how to create a personalized URL. Type the new name in the box.
- 5. Once complete, click the "**Save**" button.



URL Settings

You can create a personalized Web address for your page that will make it easier to remember for family and friends. The Web address can only contain letters, numbers, '.' (periods), '-' (dashes), and '_' (underscores). For example, if you specify 'John.Smith' as the personalized address, then the URL 'http://hhccf.convio.net/goto/John.Smith' will lead to your personalized page.
