

All Team Captains will receive an official Hope & Heroes Walk Team Captain T-shirt upon registering and will be able to wear it proudly before, after and during the Walk!

Step 3: Personalize, Personalize, Personalize!

Use your Personal Fundraising Page to tell your story and share pictures – and then use the powerful Participant Center email system to invite people to support your efforts. Every walker who uses the email system to send out 10 emails will receive a Hope & Heroes Walk car magnet!

Set a goal and ask family, friends and colleagues to contribute to a cause you care deeply about. There is no fundraising minimum, but don't set the bar too low – CHALLENGE yourself by asking 10 friends to each give \$20. You'll raise \$200 in no time!
